In order to release student photos, original student work, video footage, comments and/or post on the CCCOE website, we need written permission. To give your consent, please complete the form below. All of these photographs/video recordings shall be the property, solely and completely, of the Contra Costa County Office of Education. I waive any right to inspect or approve the finished photographs/video-tapes, audio tracks, scripts, or printed matter that may be used in conjunction with them.

Please indicate whether you will grant permission to the CCCOE/school to use photographs, original student work, or video footage of your child. The CCCOE and school's websites are accessible to all who have access to the Internet.

Please note that when the media is on campus unsolicited, we often cannot prohibit them from interviewing students or including them in photographs or news stories. This permission form is for the CCCOE/school to issue publicity.

Note: This form pertains to images used outside the school campus, and does not pertain to classroom displays or yearbook photos. If you do not want your student to appear in a yearbook, contact the school office. The CCCOE and school's website is accessible to all who have access to the Internet. It is our policy not to include last name, home address or telephone number with any work or photo posted on the website.
