4. Overall Cleanliness
 - a. Administration upper hallway stairs – debris (unkempt)
 - b. B-wing upper hall stairwell – debris in bird spikes; stairwells unswept/unkempt
 - c. Bldg. D restrooms – unkempt
 - d. North campus, bldg. 3 all stairwells – dust and debris from construction
 - e. Football building (exterior) – Walls unkempt, disrepair, exposed plywood
 - f. Football building (interior) – clutter/unkempt
 - g. P112 clutter
 5. Pest/Vermin Infestation
 - a. Football building (exterior) – Birds entering substructure at vent/eaves
 6. Electrical
 - a. Library – missing electrical cover on floor plug
 - b. Gym Back Lobby - damaged ceiling light fixture in hallway IFO team rooms
 - c. Wrestling gym restrooms – inop lights
 - d. F207 – cord management
 - e. F204 – Hood equipment control panel missing; exposed wires, inop light.
 - f. F203 – inop light
 - g. Football building (exterior) – inop light sensors
 7. Sinks and Fountains
 - a. Girls' locker room – inop faucet
 - b. Gym Bldg. (exterior) - inop drinking faucet
 - c. Football building (interior) – inop faucet

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- d. F210 – inop faucet
- 8. Structural damage
 - a. Tennis courts – asphalt uneven. Cracks reflected linear movement/settling.
 - b. Football building (exterior) – structure reflects dry rot at exterior locations
- 9. Roofs
 - a. Football building (exterior) – flashings in disrepair; screen material damaged at eaves
- 10. Playgrounds / school grounds
 - a. Tennis courts – Due to uneven surface, courts are compromised. Rain Puddles, trip/fall hazards exist. Photos reflect uneven, unsafe playing surface.
- 11. Windows/doors
 - a. F206 – missing and damaged screens
 - b. G217 – broken window
 - c. Football building (exterior) – doors/windows reflect disrepair due to age/unkept
 - d. Football building (interior) – windows boarded over, broken, missing, painted

Facilities Rating: GOOD 96.10%

Custodial level reflected extremely well. Common areas and classrooms were in great condition! Landscaping and trees in courtyard are lovely. Portables are well cared for. Teachers, staff and students were welcoming and accommodating.

Structural issues, where noted, were serious. These include the tennis courts and the football building on the North Campus.

North campus, building 3, is under construction.
